THE PEARL

3a.

(i) Empathy

- Juan Tomas hides Kino from danger
- Apolonia and Juan Tomas give Kino's family some food items on their escape journey
- Juana nurses Kino when he gets injured
- The neighbours gather around Kino's house when they hear Coyotito's cry after the scorpion bite

(ii) Greed

- Pearl buyers offer low prices
- The doctor administers toxic drugs to benefit from the pearl
- Trackers follow Kino to steal the pearl
- A pearl agent steals all the pearls from villagers

3b.

- The doctor not assisting Kino when he goes to his house leads to Kino finding a pearl which leads to Coyotito's death

- The pearl buyers trying to cheat Kino makes Kino not to sell his pearl which leads to many people attacking Kino for it and as Kino flees on the journey Coyotito is killed
- Juana giving back the pearl to Kino when she decides to throw it away leads to Coyotito's death as they flee from people who are looking for the pearl
- Kino attacking the trackers leads to Coyotito's death as Coyotito is killed by the trackers' gun
